### Child Support

- If you're receiving a Work and Income benefit that includes a sole parent rate, you're unable to cancel a formula assessment of child support.
- This form can only be completed by a custodian.

## Collecting child support

### Current and overdue payments

Please write below the amount of child support you want us to collect. Once we've collected the current and overdue payments, we'll pass on to you the amounts you're entitled to. You can give dates that you want us to collect payments from, or you can tell us a specific amount to collect. For example:

- collect only \$3,000 of the debt, **or**
- collect everything owed between 1 January and 30 June last year, **or**
- collect all current and overdue payments, but not the penalties.

You can also ask us to collect any penalties the paying parent may owe. Any penalties collected will **not** be paid to you and will be kept by the government.

- We **must** collect payments and/or penalties owed by the paying parent during any time you were receiving a Work and Income benefit that included a sole parent rate. The money we collect won't be paid to you and will be kept by the government.
- If you've asked us to collect child support, you'll receive any payments you're entitled to once they are collected, except for any penalties, which are kept by the government.

### Privacy Act 1993

Meeting your tax obligations involves giving accurate information to Inland Revenue. We ask you for information on this form so we can assess or collect your child support liability as authorised by the Child Support Act 1991.

We may exchange information about you with the Ministry of Social Development, the Ministry of Justice, the Department of Labour, the Ministry of Education, the Accident Compensation Corporation, or their contracted agencies. Information may be provided to overseas countries with which New Zealand has an information supply agreement. Inland Revenue also has an agreement to supply information to Statistics New Zealand for statistical purposes only.

You may ask to see the personal information we hold about you by calling us on **0800 221 221**. Unless we have a lawful reason for withholding the information, we will show it to you and correct any errors.
