- collect all current and overdue payments, but not the penalties.

You can also ask us to collect any penalties the paying parent may owe. Any penalties collected will not be paid to you and will be kept by the government.

Please read the notes below and sign the declaration.

Notes

- If you were receiving a sole parent rate of a Work and Income benefit, you cannot ask us to stop collecting child support payments for those periods. You can, however, still ask us to collect payment of domestic maintenance or court-ordered lump sums of child support.
- You can ask us not to collect all or part of the money owing, including any late payment penalties.
- If there is any change to your entitlement for periods you have asked us not to collect, we may need to make an adjustment. For example, if your entitlement increased, you may want to tell us not to collect that additional entitlement.
- If you do not want us to collect any future payments of child support or domestic maintenance, you must also cancel your future entitlement using the *Cancelling your child support (IR 107)* or *Election not to enforce court order (IR 112)* form. This does not prevent you from applying for child support again in the future.
- Once you have asked us not to collect payments or penalties for a particular period, you cannot at a later date ask us to collect them. However, it is still possible to collect the payments owing to you by applying through the District Court.

Meeting your tax obligations involves giving accurate information to Inland Revenue. We ask you for information on this form so we can assess or collect your child support liability as authorised by the Child Support Act 1991.

We may exchange information about you with the Ministry of Social Development, the Ministry of Justice, the Department of Labour, the Ministry of Education, the Accident Compensation Corporation, or their contracted agencies. Information may also be provided to overseas countries with which New Zealand has an information supply agreement. Inland Revenue also has an agreement to supply information to Statistics New Zealand for statistical purposes only.

You may ask to see the personal information we hold about you by calling us on 0800 221 221. Unless we have a lawful reason for withholding the information, we will show it to you and correct any errors.
