

IRD number application - individual currently in New Zealand

Complete this form if you're currently in New Zealand. If you're not in New Zealand, use the **IRD number application - offshore individual - IR742** form.

To apply for an IRD number for you or for a child in your care, complete the form and sign the declaration. Take the form with current supporting documents to an Automobile Association (AA) Driver Licensing agent so they can verify your identity.

You must provide 1 original primary identification document, and 1 original secondary identification document with your application, as well as a legible photocopy of each of your documents.

Primary identification (Category A) documents

You'll need 1 of these documents:

- New Zealand passport
- Overseas passport with a visa granted by Immigration New Zealand unless your passport is from Australia, Cook Islands, Niue or Tokelau.
- Full New Zealand birth certificate issued after 1 January 1998
- New Zealand citizenship certificate
- New Zealand firearm or dealer's licence
- New Zealand certificate of identity from the Department of Internal Affairs (DIA) or the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE)
- New Zealand refugee travel document
- New Zealand emergency travel document

Secondary identification (Category B) documents

You'll need 1 of these documents:

- New Zealand driver licence both sides of the licence are needed
- Overseas driver licence
- Kiwi Access Card
- HANZ 18+ card existing cards are valid until their expiry dates
- New Zealand student photo ID
- International Driving Permit

If you're not able to provide the required primary and secondary identification documents, please call us on 0800 775 247 to discuss your options.

If the documents you provide are in another name, you must provide an original document that confirms how your name was changed, for example, marriage certificate, official name change certificate, civil union certificate, and a legible photocopy of that document.

If you're applying for a child who is in your care, and they are under 16:

You'll need 1 primary identification document (Category A) and 1 secondary identification document (Category B) for yourself and 1 of the following for the child:

- New Zealand passport
- Full New Zealand birth certificate
- New Zealand citizenship certificate
- New Zealand student photo ID

If your child has an overseas passport, please provide it along with a visa granted by Immigration New Zealand.

If you need to use an expired passport as 1 of your identification documents for your child, you'll need to call 0800 775 247 to find out your options.

If your documents do not show your relationship with your child, you'll also need a document such as:

- Adoption papers
- Parenting orders
- Guardianship orders
- Overseas birth certificate
- Statutory declaration IR595D form you can download this from ird.govt.nz/forms-guides.

Note: If you're the parent of a new baby and you've not registered their birth yet, you can apply for your baby's IRD number at the same time as you complete the birth registration form. You do not need to complete this form or provide verification at an authorised agent if you do this.

Nominated persons

We cannot discuss your tax affairs with anyone except you. However, you can nominate someone else to do this for you. For more information go to ird.govt.nz.
