

Application for product ruling by promoter – statutory declaration

- This declaration is for use where an applicant for a product ruling is a promoter of the arrangement to which the ruling will apply.
- This declaration must be completed as part of an application for a product ruling by promoter submitted through the Request ruling or determination service in myIR.

A statutory declaration must be made by an applicant for a product ruling if the applicant is the promoter of the arrangement. The declaration must be witnessed by a solicitor, Justice of the Peace or any other person authorised to take a statutory declaration under section 9 of the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957.
