Thank you for your request made under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), received on 25 July 2025. You requested the following:

On 5 July 2024, you responded to our OIA request about provisional tax paid on 7 May by March balance date taxpayers for the 2022, 2023 and 2024 years. (24OIA2307) Can you please provide the same information for the 2025 year, using the same filters as before. i.e. total payments made between 23 April 2025 and 19 May 2025 for customers who had residual income tax of \$5000 or more for the previous tax year, and a standard balance date of 31 March.

Information being released

The information you have requested can be found in the table below. This table shows the number of customers, number of transactions, and total value of provisional tax payments (including transfers) made between the dates of 23 April to 19 May 2025 for customers who had an RIT of \$5,000 or more for the 2024 tax year and a standard balance date of 31 March. The data below is as at 29 July 2025 and is subject to change if transfers are made to the income tax account with an effective date between 23 April and 19 May 2025.
